Did you know:

- Blue Ridge Lumber /Ranger Board each give an annual scholarship of \$1,000.00 to students who are continuing their education?
- They are available to high school graduates from Whitecourt, Mayerthorpe, and Barrhead areas?
- They are NOT necessarily awarded to the graduate with the highest marks?

To apply for the scholarship:

- 1. Pick up an application form from your high school office
- 2. Complete the application form and essay, and forward them to the Payroll Department, Blue Ridge Lumber/Ranger Board
- 3. Deadline for the application is **May 1** of each year

A copy of the most recent academic transcript must accompany the application, and enrollment in a post-secondary education institution must be confirmed before the award is granted.

The Selection Committee will:

- Give priority to students entering a post secondary program that could lead to a career in the forest industry (for example, forestry, environmental studies, engineering, business administration)
- Give priority to students who complete an essay providing specifics about which program he/she is planning on entering, and why
- Give priority to students who demonstrate involvement in extra-curricular activities at school and/or within the community
- > Consult with the principals at the high schools from which applicants are received.
- Make the contribution in the amount of \$1000 each to the school of the successful applicant(s) in order to avoid deducting income tax - the school will in turn write the successful applicant(s) a cheque for the same amount.
