Principal's Message

COVID Update

We continue to restrict access to the school during this time. This means that parents will not be able to come into the school without an appointment. We look forward to the day when all this is behind us but we certainly appreciate your cooperation with us as we seek to reduce the social interaction here at the school for the time being.

The Alberta Government has mandated that schools will remain closed to Grade 7 to 12 students from November 30th until January 7th. Instruction for these students during this time will be online. Grades K to 6 will continue with face to face instruction until December 18th. All students will attend school remotely from January 4th to January 8th. Staff will be returning to work on the 4th and students are expected to participate in the lessons that will be provided for the week. We will provide more information about what this will look like by the middle of December.



COVID-19 INFORMATION

COVID-19 ALBERTA HEALTH DAILY CHECKLIST (FOR CHILDREN UNDER 18)

Overview

This checklist applies for all children, as well as all students who attend kindergarten to Grade 12, including high school students over 18. Children should be screened every day by completing this checklist before going to school, child care or other activities. Children may need a parent or guardian to assist them to complete this screening tool.

Screening Questions

1. Has the child:

(Choose any/all possible exposures)

Traveled outside Canada in the last 14 days?	YES	NO
When entering or returning to Alberta from outside Canada, individuals are legally		
required to quarantine for 14 days unless enrolled in the Alberta COVID-19		
International Border Pilot Project		
Had close contact with a case of COVID-19 in the last 14 days?	YES	NO
Face-to-face contact within 2 metres for 15 minutes or longer, or direct physical		
contact such as hugging		

If the child answered "YES" to any of the above:

- The child is required to quarantine for 14 days from the last day of exposure.
 - If the child is participating in the Alberta COVID-19 International Border Pilot Project, they must comply with the program restrictions at all times.
- If the child develops any symptoms, use the <u>AHS Online Assessment Tool</u> or call Health Link 811 to determine if testing is recommended.

If the child answered "NO" to both of the above:

Proceed to question 2.

If the child answered "YES" to any symptom in question 2:

- The child is to isolate for 10 days from onset of symptoms.
- Use the AHS Online Assessment Tool or call Health Link 811 to arrange for testing and to receive additional information on isolation.

If the child answered "NO" to all of the symptoms in question 2:

• Proceed to question 3.

If the child answered "YES" to ONE symptom in question 3:

- · Keep your child home and monitor for 24 hours.
- If their symptom is **improving** after 24 hours, they can return to school and activities when they feel well enough to go. Testing is not necessary.
- If the symptom does not improve or worsens after 24 hours (or if additional symptoms emerge), use the AHS Online Assessment Tool or call Health Link 811 to check if testing is recommended.

If the child answered "YES" to TWO OR MORE symptoms in question 3:

- Keep your child home.
- Use the <u>AHS Online Assessment Tool</u> or call Health Link 811 to determine if testing is recommended.
- Your child can return to school and activities once their symptoms go away as long as it
 has been at least 24 hours since their symptoms started.

If the child answered "NO" to all questions:

· Your child may attend school, child care and/or other activities.

Please note: If your child is experiencing any symptoms from the lists above, do not bring them to visit a continuing care or acute care facility for 10 days from when symptoms started/until symptoms resolve (whichever is longer), unless they receive a negative COVID-19 test result and feel better.

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Fox Creek Library is currently unable to offer in-person programming due to Covid-19 restrictions. If you would like a take home kit for one of the activities, give them a call to see if they still have any available. Supplies are limited.
