



Hello Fox Creek School Families:

As you are likely aware, all schools in Alberta are being temporarily shifted to online (remote) learning at the end of this week. Here's the plan for our school:

On Thursday, May 6 staff will help students pack up the resources and materials they will need for the next two weeks. Students will be dismissed at the usual dismissal time. They will take their learning materials home with them.

Online learning / remote instruction will get underway on Friday morning, May 7 for all grades. Your child will continue to learn with their current teachers. A google meet link may be sent to their gmail or google classroom. Google logins are as follows: firstname.lastname @ngps.ca If your child encounters any difficulties logging in please contact their teacher.

Kindergarten through Grade 6 classes will have a focus on literacy and numeracy for the next two-week period.

Grades 7-12 classes will continue with all the courses in which they are currently enrolled.

Before May 7, your child's teacher will connect with you or your child to share a more specific learning plan for the next two weeks. The expectation is that students will connect with their teachers, engage in lessons and complete work assigned every school day during this two-week period. Attendance will be taken. If parents have any questions or concerns please contact your child's teachers as soon as possible. If you are unable to connect with your child's teacher feel free to contact the office for assistance.

Students who have requested a chromebook for use over the two week period will be assigned a chromebook on Thursday to take home with them at the end of the day. If there are issues with chromebooks please do not hesitate to reach out to the school for assistance.

The school will be open for appointments or answering phone calls from 8:15 to 3:45 each day.
